

Contaminated Soil Removal In Gallagher Park

A western section of Gallagher Park, in the Ski Club area near the Peace Dove, is temporarily closed while the City completes remediation work near the former incinerator site. The work is expected to be completed by Fall, and will pause for the Folk Fest. The bike/walking path will remain open.

The remediation will include removing contaminated soil and replacing it with 30cm of clean soil and sod. The City reports that the contamination has been

present at the site for decades, but the grass has provided a layer of protection. Replacing it now will ensure safety in the future for park users and city workers. The site was previously a dumping ground for the incinerator, which was active from the 1930s until 1971.

City's Live Active Green Shack Update

Get kids active and join in on games, sport, crafts, music, drama and special events! A complete list of activities and special events is posted on the side of Green Shacks each week. If there is a game or activity that piques your child's interest that you would like to have included in the programming, just ask the Program Leader (wearing blue shirts). Program leaders will be hosting a variety of games, challenges and activities that are sure to get kids active and having fun!

Cloverdale's Green Shack is located near the Community Hall porch and the gazebo in Gallagher Park. The program runs from July 12–Aug 27, and is run by a City program leader from 10:30 AM until 1:30 PM on Mondays through Fridays.

Program Leaders have completed a security clearance process & are trained in first aid. Parents are responsible for their children at all times and must be available in the event of an emergency.

Have Your Next Event At The Cloverdale Community League Hall!

The Cloverdale Community League Hall is available for bookings! The Cloverdale Community League Hall offers a year-round destination to celebrate family milestones or to build corporate bonds. Nestled in the heart of the Edmonton, the hall is located in majestic Gallagher Park and is a short walk away from the North Saskatchewan River trail network, the Edmonton Ski Club and the renowned Muttart Conservatory.

Gallagher Park is ideal for recreational activities such as sledding, picnicking, and skating at the League's Ice Rink. The spray park (in operation from roughly May to September) and playground are great for kids.

The Lounge area and/or the Main Hall are available to rent, and the amenities include the kitchen, bar, some tech equipment, and the beautiful outdoor space around the hall.

The hall can be booked for \$50/hr for events up to 5 hours, \$300 for 5–8 hour events, \$600 for over 8 hours, \$1000 for two days, and upon request for longer events. The \$300 and \$600 events receive \$50 off if the event is a weekday. Visit our website for the most up to date pricing and availability.
