RE: Edmonton Folk Music Festival and Cloverdale Community League Wristband Agreement

Dear Jayne;

The purpose of this letter is to outline the wristband agreement between the Edmonton Folk Music Festival (EFMF) and the Cloverdale Community League (CCL) for the festival occurring August 4 - 7 2022.

The EFMF will provide the following to the CCL:

- Five hundred and twenty-five (525) non-transferrable weekend wristbands.
 - The CCL will be responsible for administration and disbursement of wristbands.
 - The wristbands must be put on eligible community members at the time of disbursement.
 - The CCL will ensure only eligible community members receive wristbands.
 - The CCL will return any unused or unclaimed wristbands to the EFMF on or before August 4 2022
- Should the initial five hundred and twenty-five wristbands be insufficient to meet the needs of eligible community members, the EFMF will allow the CCL to request additional wristbands at face value + GST. The cost of which will be subtracted from the rental fee charged to the EFMF for their use of the CCL hall rental for the 2022 festival.



- The CCL will provide an accounting of wristbands to the EFMF at the conclusion of their disbursement process.
 - This accounting must include:
 - Address of residence receiving wristbands
 - Number of wristbands disbursed per address

This agreement is in effect for the 2022 Edmonton Folk Music Festival only. A new agreement between the EFMF and CCL will be discussed no later than December 2022 with the intent of reaching a long term agreement.
